As regards to the 50th Anniversary of Cameroon's Reunification, the date for the celebrations and further information will be communicated later on in liaison with the National Organizing Committee of the Fiftieth Anniversaries of the Independence and Reunification of Cameroon.

The High Commissioner would like to thank all Cameroonians for the preparatory work done so far. He also wishes to remind them that articles for the Special Magazine and essays for the Essay Competition for Cameroonian children are still welcomed.
