## **Provisional Register of Electors Living in the United Kingdom.**

In view of the Presidential Election of 9 October 2011, the High Commission for the Republic of Cameroon hereby informs Cameroonians that the Provisional Register of Electors living in the United Kingdom of Great-Britain and Northern Ireland was adopted by the Commission charged with the drawing up and revision of Registers of electors during its meeting of 7<sup>th</sup> September 2011 in London. The total number of electors registered is 303.

The adoption of the said Register and its onward transmission to the Directorate General of Elections, Elections Cameroon (ELECAM) concluded the voter registration process launched on 13<sup>th</sup> August 2011 with the installation of the ELECAM Focal Point of the Chancellery in London. Despite time constraints, the activities to register Cameroonians on the voter's lists were conducted smoothly and in accordance with Law n° 2011/013 of 13 July 2011 relating to voting by Cameroonian citizens settled or residing abroad and its Decree of implementation N° 2011/237 of 8 August 2011.

The High Commission wishes to invite Cameroonians registered, to consult the "Provisional Register" posted at the Chancellery in London.

Request for correction, amendments or complaints should be made to the Electoral Board of ELECAM through the good office of the ELECAM Focal Point, at the High Commission in London.

The High Commission expresses its appreciation to Cameroonians who decided to register on the voters list. It would like to remind them that, as stipulated in articles 8,9,10,11,12 and 13 of Decree N° 2011/237 of 8 August to lay down conditions for implementing Law N° 2011/013 of 13 July 2011 relating to voting by Cameroonian citizens settled or residing abroad, the final Register of Electors certified by the Director General of Elections should be posted up **no later than 15 days before** the day of the poll while voter's cards should be distributed **during the 15 days preceding** the poll.
