VISA REQUIREMENTS

1. – DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED:

- a) - A passport valid for at least 6 months.
- b) - 2 completed application forms (available at the High Commission and on www.cameroonhighcommission.co.uk) please send a stamped self-addressed envelope.
- c) - 2 clear passport-size photographs taken frontally.
- d) - A legalised letter of invitation with the Cameroon Police from either the host/contact/partner in Cameroon and a letter of sponsorship from the applicant's well-known employer/establishment/organisation (in the case of a private or business visit).
- e) - Return or continuation ticket;
- f) - Bank statement (at least £1,000.00), except where a Tour Operator/Travel agency is organising a trip.
- g) - Travel Insurance.
- h) - Marriage certificate for mixed couple and a letter from the Cameroonian partner.
- i) - Child's Birth Certificate and a letter from one or both parents allowing him/her to travel.

2.– OFFICIAL/DIPLOMATIC/COURTESY VISAS.

- i. Items a, b, c, and a note verbale are required.
- ii. Conditions of reciprocity apply.

3.– APPLICATION PROCEDURE.

- Completed applications should be lodged at the Reception Desk of the High Commission between 9.30 and 12.30, Monday to Friday, except on bank, (public) holidays: (England and Cameroon).
- The presence of visa applicants at the High Commission may be required for purposes of identification.
- Collection is between 2.30pm and 4.00pm every working day.

4.– TOURIST, BUSINESS AND TRANSIT VISAS.

Requirements are listed in paragraph a, b, c, d and e.

5.- VISA APPLICATION FEES ARE AS FOLLOWS AS AT 22 FEBRUARY 2010.

- 1 day to 3 months = £59.00

N.B: In cash or postal money order please. The above amounts are subject to variation.

6.- CURRENCY REGULATIONS (ON ENTRY):

Importation: No limit on amount of foreign currency. Total amount must be declared for travelling residents

Exportation: The amount of local currency (cash) that can be exported is limited to 1.500 F.CFA = £20.00.

7.- SANITARY REQUIREMENTS:

Compulsory vaccines:

1. Yellow Fever,
2. Cholera (if coming from affected area). Proof required at port of entry.

Recommended Vaccines:

3. Typhoid,
4. Meningitis,
5. Malaria protection.

8.- FIREARMS:

The importation of firearms is subject to prior authorisation by competent Cameroonian authorities. Applications can be made through the High Commission.

9.- JOURNALISTS AND CINEMATOGRAPHERS.

6. Require accreditation to operate in Cameroon.
7. Forms are available at the High Commission or to be downloaded from the Ministry of Communication website (www.mincom.gov.cm).
8. All accreditation formalities are completed by the competent Department of the Ministry of Communication in Yaounde.
9. The above conditions do not apply to amateur/tourist photography. Airports, military personnel in uniform and strategic sites may not be photographed.

10.- SEAMEN:

The Port Police will issue authorisations to seamen stopping over if they need to leave the Port area. They must have ample justification./-


